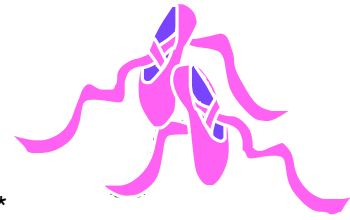

Pre-Dance Program



Welcome “Spotlight Dancers” to the Fall 2009 session of the Pre-Dance program at Ben Lomond Community Center. My goal is to introduce dance, encourage and motivate student, to promote self esteem, and allow for peer interaction while following instructions.

Class Session: The class session will run for 12 weeks. The last scheduled class will be:
December 7th for Monday students
December 8th for Tuesday students
December 16th for Wednesday students
December 10th for Thursday students
December 11th for Friday students

Attire: Girls are required to wear leotards and tights, and pink leather ballet shoes(no satin ballet slippers), and black tap shoes. Girls may wear a skirt over the leotard if the student does not get distracted by it. Boys are required to wear a t-shirt with dance pants or sweat pants, black ballet shoes, and black tap shoes. Please write your child’s name in all shoes to prevent mix-ups.

Restroom: Please make sure your child has used the restroom before class. The instructors and helpers can only escort the children to the restroom. They are not permitted to assist in any way inside the restroom. If your child needs help in the restroom please remain in the building.

Scheduled Breaks: Classes will not be held November 11th and November 24th thru November 27th.

Inclement Weather: We follow the Prince William County School System for weather related closings. If the Prince William Schools close, Ben Lomond classes are canceled. If the Prince William Schools open on a 2 hour delay all classes 10:30 am and before are canceled. Call Ben Lomond Community Center at 703-361-7126 if you are unsure of weather cancellations.

Watch Days: Parents are invited to observe the dance classes during their first class in September and the first week in November. At the last scheduled class in December, students will demonstrate what they have learned throughout the session at a show held at Ben Lomond during their regularly scheduled class time.
