General Comments made by citizens

Use the park as a cultural resource site
Keep pets in identified areas
Will signs be placed on Route 66?
Biking events could become an issue if allowed

Horse trails should not go around the lake

Development Requests

Allow people to bring their own boats
Non-motorized boats should be allowed
Shelters for picnicking
Allow camping, but just around holidays
The quarry should be used for swimming
Evening fishing after sunset
Install electronic surveillance
School programming should be developed at the Park Authority Set aside 60 acres for a shooting range
Charge fees to enter the park
Add a dog park from 1-5 acres
Add trail connections to trails outside of Park Authority
Equestrian swimming
Disc golf
Allow community gardens
Primitive camping with potable water
Add water sprinklers for children to cool off
Swimming fishing and boating in the same area
