



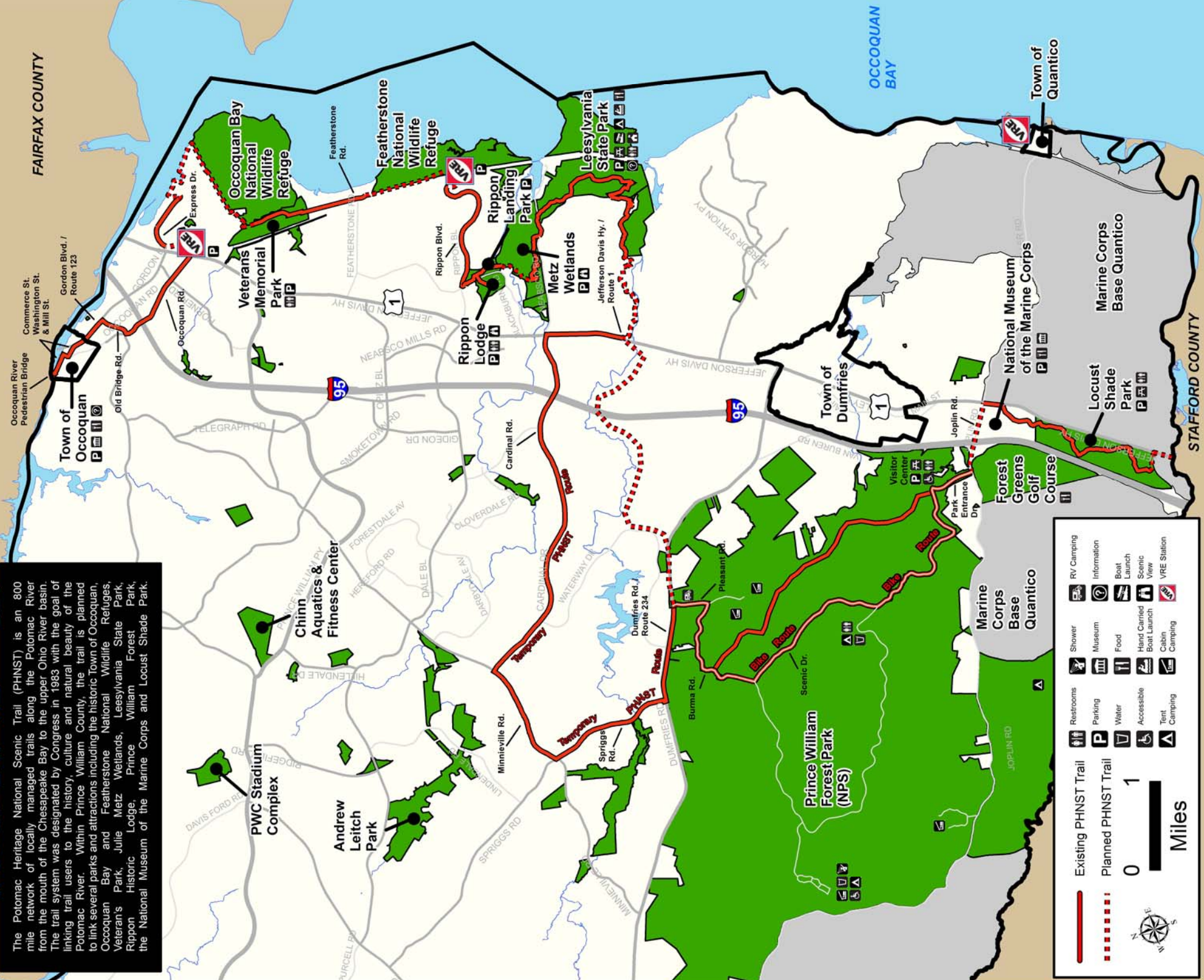
# POTOMAC HERITAGE NATIONAL SCENIC TRAIL

Prince William County, Virginia



The Potomac Heritage National Scenic Trail (PHNST) is an 800 mile network of locally managed trails along the Potomac River from the mouth of the Chesapeake Bay to the upper Ohio River basin. The trail system was designated by Congress in 1983 with the goal of linking trail users to the history, culture and natural beauty of the Potomac River. Within Prince William County, the trail is planned to link several parks and attractions including the historic town of Occoquan, Occoquan Bay and Featherstone National Wildlife Refuges, Veterans' Park, Julie Metz Wetlands, Leesylvania State Park, Rippon Lodge, Prince William Forest Park, the National Museum of the Marine Corps and Locust Shade Park.
